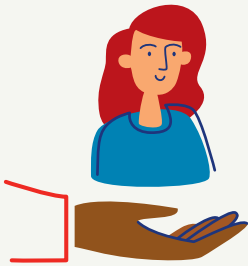

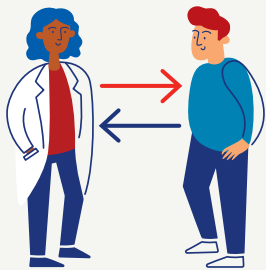

Your questions answered

Can I schedule an appointment at Walgreens to receive the COVID-19 vaccine?

How many shots of COVID-19 vaccine are required?

Both the Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines require two shots to be as effective as possible. The Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine requires just one shot.

How will Walgreens coordinate vaccines with two doses?

For vaccines that require two shots, Walgreens schedules both appointments at the same time as part of the scheduling experience.

When are people considered fully vaccinated?

Two weeks after the second dose in a 2-dose series, or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine. Fully vaccinated people should keep wearing a mask and social distancing in public places.

Are COVID-19 vaccines safe?

Vaccines have played an important role in protecting the health and safety of communities and nations throughout history. As a critical resource for care in our communities, Walgreens will remain focused on providing safe and convenient access to COVID-19 vaccines.
